

Guidelines for Discovery Church COVID-19 Response

Sunday Protocol

Step 1: Every person needs to stop by the table outside.

1. Temperatures will be taken – any temperature above 99.9 degrees will not be allowed to come in.
2. Gloves/Masks are available.
 - a. All greeters and ushers will be required to wear masks.
 - b. People are encouraged to bring their own masks.
3. Hand sanitizer available at sanitizer stations.
 - a. By front door
 - b. In children's area
 - c. By Kiosk
 - d. By bathrooms

Step 2: Entering the building

1. Church doors will remain open, so no one is touching the doors.
2. Each person should use hand sanitizer as they walk in.
3. Entering the sanctuary – doors will remain open – one usher will close the doors when service starts and during service and open the doors when service ends.

Step 3: Heading into the sanctuary:

1. Each family will find a seat in the sanctuary. Overflow room is available.
2. Family units will sit together.
3. There will be no children's service at this time.
 - a. Coloring pictures, activities and crayons will be provided for the children during service.
4. Make sure two seats are between each family group.
5. Do not give hugs or shake hands.
6. There will be an usher or two that can answer any questions that may arise.

Step 4: Restrooms/Kiosk

1. Each person should sanitize their hands before they use the Kiosk/Offering container (Gloves will also be available at the Kiosk).
 - a. We encourage giving online if congregants are comfortable with that.
 - b. Envelopes will be available at the Kiosk.
2. Hands should be sanitized before using the bathroom.
3. Hands should be thoroughly washed after using the bathroom.

Step 5: Dismissal from Church

1. Senior congregants will be dismissed first (65 and older).
2. The rest of the congregation will be dismissed by rows.
3. If you plan to linger and talk, please do so outside, maintaining social distancing.

Miscellaneous:

1. No bulletins will be handed out at this time.
2. No food or drinks will be served.
3. Communion will be given through pre-packaged cup and wafers.
